## FROM STUDENT/PARENT HANDBOOK

"Students taking exams will be required to stay in the classroom the entire exam period. No early release will be given and students must take their exam during their scheduled time." DO NOT PERMIT STUDENTS TO LEAVE THE CLASSROOM, OR HANG OUT IN THE HALLS. If a student needs to leave after completing the exam, but before the class period is over, a parent <u>MUST come to the office to sign out the</u> <u>student.</u>

"Any course with an unexcused absence cannot be exempted. If a student has an unexcused absence for a six weeks, a note excusing the absence must be turned in to the office no later than a week after report cards have been handed out.

An exemption form must be obtained from the school office prior to the exam and must be completely filled out and signed by the teacher and school secretary before an exemption is approved.

No student may be exempt from any exam if they owe any money to the school district including overdue/lost library books, cafeteria, lost/damaged textbooks, uniforms, etc. Also, if a student has a detention not served, they will not be allowed to exempt from any exams."

Students may walk off Campus during lunch; however, if a student owes anything to the school (Cafeteria, Library, Books, Band items, Athletic items, etc...) he or she will not be allowed to walk off. Mr. Deaver will have a list in the cafeteria and will check that the student is present.)
